In reality, the “code numbering” for processes may follow:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i) scheme &amp; nomenclature as mandated by statutory bodies (if applicable) or and</li> <li>ii) company’s own proprietary convention, as decided by concerned functions or organisations or and</li> </ul>	

iii) as driven by an “Inbuilt coding scheme” in the company's chosen/selected ERP or software package.
